Authorizing the Director of Procurement to execute a \$240,000.00 contract amendment for Becoming a Man & Working on Womanhood Services; authorizing the Director of Health to expend \$240,000.00 (for a total contract amount of \$630,000.00; and authorizing the Director of Procurement to extend the term of the contracts or increase or decrease the total contract dollar amounts upon need and appropriation without further Council approval.) with the University of Missouri-Kansas City to provide program services for Becoming a Man & Working on Womanhood.

WHEREAS, this additional funding will allow this program to continue for another school year; NOW, THEREFORE;

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the <u>DirectorManager</u> of <u>Procurement Services</u> is authorized to execute a contract amendment with the University of Missouri-Kansas City, for \$240,000.00, and a total contract amount not to exceed \$630,000.00 to provide program services for the provision of Becoming a Man & Working on Womanhood-<u>Services</u>. A copy of the contract, in substantial form, is on file with the Director of Health.

Section 2. That the Director of Health is authorized to expend \$240,000.00 from funds previously appropriated to the following account:

Section 3. That the Director of Procurement is authorized to execute contract amendments and extend the contract for up to five (5) one year renewal terms without additional Council authorization.
