Kansas City Lead Facts:

- ▶600+ children currently suffer from lead poisoning
- >~1,200 children have undiagnosed lead poisoning
- >79% of housing is "at-risk" for lead-based paint hazards (160,000 homes)



2024 Lead Safe KC Grant:

- **≻6.4 million dollars HUD** OHHLHC funding
- >Period of performance Dec. 2024-Dec. 2028 (48 months)

LSKC Grant Goals

- Prevent lead poisoning in 170 homes by removing lead paint hazards in homes of low-income families with young children/pregnant women.
- Identify lead paint hazards in 180 pre-1978 homes.
- Support 10 small business lead abatement contractors
- <u>Increase</u> community capacity by providing free training for 120 lead abatement workers, companies and young adults.



Lead Safe KC Eligibility

Owner-Occupied Properties

- Home built before 1978
- Must be a KCMO address
- Household income is ≤80% AMI (Area Median Income)
- Have either:
 - A child under age 6 living in or frequently visiting the home
 - A pregnant person living in the home

Rental Properties

- Owner must apply
- Rental unit built before 1978
- Must be a KCMO address
- Rental unit is occupied
- Tenant's household income is ≤80% AMI
