Brief Title

Changing and re-establishing the grades for the N Woodland Ave Complete Streets project

Approval Deadline

Reason

Changing and re-establishing the grades of N Woodland Ave from NE 96th Street to Shoal Creek Parkway and adjoining cross streets as part of the "N Woodland Complete Streets" project.

Details

Reason for Legislation

For the public good it is necessary that the grades on N. Woodland Avenue, from a point +/- 250 feet south of the intersection of Northeast 96th Street, north to Northeast 108th Street, all in Kansas City, Clay County, Missouri, be changed and re-established.

Discussion

Directing the City Clerk to cause a notice of said grade changes to be published in the newspaper doing the city printing, on each day of issue of said newspaper for a period of ten (10) days, starting on or about the date following the passage of this ordinance, and providing a period of thirty (30) days for remonstrance starting the same day as the first day of the publication.

Said grade changes shall be of the nature described and specified in, and shall be done in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared and certified by the Engineer under the supervision of the Director of Parks and Recreation and identified as KCMO Project Number 70052304, 70172340, and 70182903, "N Woodland Complete Streets", the same being on file in the Office of the Director of Parks and Recreation and being incorporated herein by reference.
