Purpose

- HOPWA is the only Federal program dedicated to the housing needs of people living with HIV.
- HOPWA provides housing assistance and related supportive services for low-income people living with HIV and their families.

Housing = healthcare

- Increased engagement in HIV medical care and treatment
- Increased viral suppression of HIV, which prevents HIV transmission
- Improves long-term health outcomes & quality of life for people with HIV

HIV CARE CONTINUUM:

The series of steps a person with HIV takes from initial diagnosis through their successful treatment with HIV medication
