Executive Summary

Authorizing the City of Kansas City Missouri – Aviation Department to execute Contract No. 6222120063, a Lease and Concession Agreement with Terminal C Hotel, LLC for a development on approximately four (4) acres of land for the purpose of developing, constructing and operation a hotel on the grounds of the Kansas City International Airport. The hotel will be a four (4) floor hotel with a total room count of 163 rooms and a total building area of 85,920 SF. The property will feature 163 total parking stalls.
