REGULATION NUMBERS 66398 THROUGH 66407 INSTALLATIONS

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to the authority granted in paragraph (b) of Section 70-38 of the “Code of General Ordinances of Kansas City, Missouri” and subject to the provisions thereof, traffic regulations are hereby made and adopted as follows:

All vehicular traffic shall **Stop** before entering the following intersection(s) and shall be added to the list as contained in **Section 70-335**:

<u>Regulation Number</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Direction of Restriction</u>
66398	Charlotte Street and 52nd Street	Northbound
66399	Charlotte Street and 53rd Street	Southbound, Eastbound, and Westbound
66400	Holmes Street and 52nd Street (north)	Northbound, Southbound, and Eastbound
66401	Holmes Street and 52nd Street (south)	Northbound, Southbound, and Westbound
66402	Walnut Street and 2 nd Street	Northbound, Southbound, Eastbound, and Westbound

The following Street(s) is (are) designated as a **One-Way Street(s)** and shall be added to the list as contained in **Section 70-421:**

<u>Regulation Number</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Direction of Restriction</u>
66403	52nd Street, from Holmes Street to Charlotte Street	Westbound

Stopping, Standing and/or Parking shall be prohibited (as indicated) on the following street(s) and shall be added to the list as contained in **Section 70-530:**

<u>Regulation Number</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Restriction</u>
66404	53rd Street, north side, from Holmes Street to Charlotte Street	No Parking Anytime
66405	54th Street, south side, from Holmes Street to Charlotte Street	No Parking Anytime
66406	Charlotte Street, west side, from 52nd Street to 53rd Street	No Parking Anytime
66407	Holmes Street, west side, from 52nd Street (north drive) to 52nd Street (south drive)	No Parking Anytime

The locations affected by the above regulations will be marked in accordance with standards prescribed in the “Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways” and said regulations shall become effective five days after publication in The Daily Record.
