

**GREY OAKS COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT**

**INITIAL SHORT FISCAL YEAR JULY 15, 2025 THROUGH APRIL 30, 2026**

**BUDGET MESSAGE**

Grey Oaks Community Improvement District ("District") was created by Ordinance No. 250513 ("Ordinance"), adopted by the City Council of the City of Kansas City, Missouri, on July 17, 2025, pursuant to the Community Improvement District Act, Sections 67.1401 *et seq.*, RSMo ("Act"). The District desires to fund, or assist in the funding of, certain services and improvements as allowed by Sections 67.1401 to 67.1571 RSMo, as amended.

On July 24, 2025, the District's Board of Directors passed Resolution 2025:03 which imposed, upon approval of the qualified voters of the District, a maximum rate on one percent (1%) sales tax ("Sales Tax") on retail sales in the District for a maximum period of 20 years from the effective date of the Ordinance in accordance with the Act. The sales tax is expected to become effective in 2026.

The District's fiscal year begins May 1 and ends April 30 of each year.

**BUDGET SUMMARY**

The budget is presented in accordance with the requirements of Missouri statute on a cash basis.
