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SECTION III

PURPOSES OF CID AND SERVICES PERFORMED DURING FISCAL YEAR:

The purposes of the District are to: (a) provide or cause to be provided for the benefit of the District, certain services ("the Eligible Services") described below; (b) issue obligations ("CID Debt") to finance the costs of the Eligible Services, other costs incurred by the District to carry out its purposes, and costs of issuance, capitalized interest and a debt service reserve fund related to the issuance of the CID Debt; and (c) authorize and collect a sales and use tax.

The Eligible Services may generally include, but are not necessarily limited to, the interior and exterior renovations of the InterContinental Hotel and structural improvements to its parking garage. The District provided repair services for guestroom wall vinyl renovation, mechanical, electrical and plumbing in those selected guestrooms as well as roof repairs, and stucco repair/replacement on the exterior of the building.

The District’s source of revenue is a one percent (1.0%) sales and use tax (the “District Sales Tax”) imposed pursuant to the Missouri Community Improvement District Act, Sections 67-1545 to 67-1551 of the Missouri Statutes and approved by the qualified voters of the District by a sale tax election held on December 20, 2016. The District Sales Tax commenced on April 1, 2017 and shall continue until the earlier of (i) satisfaction of the CID Debt or (ii) 20 years following the effective date of the ordinance establishing

the District. On May 10th, 2017, the Board of Directors of the District adopted Resolution No. 2017-03 which authorized the District to issue a CID Revenue Note in an aggregate principal amount equal to Sixteen Million One-Hundred Five Thousand Nine Hundred One and 46/100 Dollars (\$16,105,901.46) (the “Revenue Note”) for the purpose of reimbursing TPG KC MO I, LLC (the “Developer”) for the cost of the Eligible Services incurred by Developer.

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to fill a vacant seat on the Board and the Board wishes to appoint a Successor Director to fill the vacancy; and

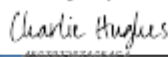

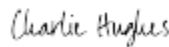

EXHIBIT A

THE INTERCONTINENTAL COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT MAY 1, 2025 – APRIL 30, 2026 BUDGET (FYE-2026)

BUDGET MESSAGE:

The InterContinental Community Improvement District (the "District") was formed as a political subdivision of the State of Missouri on October 6, 2016 by virtue of an ordinance approved by the City Council of Kansas City, Missouri. The District will serve as an economic development tool that allows landowners in the District to provide public and private improvements. The District has adopted a fiscal year of May 1st to April 30th.

Important Budget Features:

The District's source of revenue is sales and use taxes pursuant to the Missouri Community Improvement District Act, Sections 67-1545 to 67-1551 of the Missouri Statutes and approved by the qualified voters of the District by a sale tax election held on December 20, 2016 and the CID Revenue Note approved by the Board of Directors of the District (the "Board") on May 10, 2017.

The District was formed to (i) provide or cause to be provided for the benefit of the District, certain services ("the Eligible Services"), (ii) issue obligations ("CID Debt") to finance the costs of the Eligible Services, other costs incurred by the District to carry out its purposes, and costs of issuance, capitalized interest and a debt service reserve fund related to the issuance of the CID Debt, (iii) authorize and collect a sales and use tax ("District Sales Tax"), (iv) plan Eligible Services and/or public and private improvements which are deemed by the District to be necessary and desirable to the economic viability of the District, (v) implement the Eligible Services and public improvements; and (vi) share the costs incurred by the District through sales and use taxes. The Eligible Services may generally include, but are not necessarily limited to, the interior and exterior renovations of the InterContinental Hotel and structural improvements to its parking garage.
