





Bids for the above referenced project were received and opened on December 9, 2025 with three (3) bidders responding as follows:

The lowest, responsible, and responsive bid was submitted by MegaKC Corporation.

Project Description

The project consists of the renovation of the Blue River Treatment Admin Building for the purposes of ADA compliance upgrades to the existing facility per the 2011 Piper Wind Accessibility Recommendations Report. This also includes renovations to the existing locker rooms to provide separated locker rooms for men, women, and gender neutral. Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing renovations are included to align with the new layouts. Also, the project includes exterior window replacement and a new entry vestibule.

MBE/WBE Participation

The MBE/WBE goals for this project are 11% MBE and 11% WBE business participation. MegaKC Corporation. submitted their Contractor Utilization Plan with 11% MBE and 11% WBE business participation. MegaKC also has no violations of the City's MBE/WBE program. Their subcontractors (4 Gen Construction, Eiberger Construction, Kansas City Mechanical, Hartline Construction and Whatever It Takes Electrical Contractors) which were selected for this project are currently certified in the City's MBE/WBE program.

Financial Statement

A review of MegaKC Corporation’s financial standing using the Dun & Bradstreet (D&B) ratings was performed. The review indicated that MegaKC Corporation has a D&B rating of 4A3. The company is at a “low-moderate” risk level.

Claims and Lawsuits

MegaKC Corporation has no liens or other judgments against the company.

I recommend the City move forward and contract MegaKC Corporation with a bid price of \$1,859,852.00, and a 10% contingency (\$185,985.00) thus resulting in a total project cost of **\$2,045,837.00.**
