Executive Summary

Authorizing the City Attorney to execute a specialized Legal Services Contract with the law firm of Grant & Eisenhofer, P.A. for the provision of legal services related to certain firefighter protective gear; and waiving contract solicitation and award provisions

Discussion

This ordinance would authorize the City attorney to engage the law firm of Grant & Eisenhofer, P.A. to provide legal representation of the City in connection with pursuing one or more lawsuits, from pre-suit investigation through final appeal, against all those responsible for developing, designing, manufacturing, distributing marketing, selling, providing, or otherwise facilitating delivery and utilization of firefighter turnout gear known or suspected or believed to contain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances ("PFAS"). The firm has expertise with these issues and is currently representing other governmental entities in similar lawsuits. The representation is on a contingent fee basis and does not require the City to advance any funds.
