ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 THE VILLAGES COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

Budget Message

The Villages Community Improvement District (the "District") was formed on January 8, 2015, by Ordinance No. 141067 adopted by the City Council and is a public body created under the authority of the Missouri Community Improvement District Act, Section 67.1401, et seq. RSMo, as amended (the "CID Act"). The CID Act requires the Board of Directors of the District to hold an annual meeting and adopt an annual budget. The fiscal year of the District is, pursuant to the CID Act, the same as the fiscal year of the City, which runs from May 1 of the current year to April 30 of the following year.

This annual budget pertains to the District as contemplated by its Board of Directors for the fiscal year beginning on May 1, 2019 and ending on April 30, 2020. This annual budget contains the following important features, pursuant to Section 67.010.1 RSMo:

- 1. A Budget Message;
- Estimated revenues from all sources for FY 2019, itemized by fund and source, together with a comparison of such estimated revenues for FY 2018 and FY 2017;
- Proposed expenditures for each classification for FY 2019, together with a comparison of such estimated expenditures for FY 2018 and FY 2017;
- 4. The amount required for the payment of interest, amortization, and redemption charges on the debt of the District; and
- 5. A Budget Summary.

The District is not authorized to impose special assessments within the District. Resolution No. 2015-09 of the District approved the imposition of a one percent (1%) sales and use tax on sales within the District, as approved by the qualified voters of the District.

Budget Summary

This annual budget for FY 2019 shows an estimated beginning balance of \$0.00, estimated total revenues of \$240,800.00, estimated total expenditures of \$240,800.00, and an estimated ending balance of \$0.00. Pursuant to Section 67.010.2 RSMo, the total proposed expenditures do not exceed the estimated revenues to be received plus any unencumbered balance estimated for the beginning of the budget year.
