According to B2G, the prime contractor is currently achieving the following participation on the contract:

Dollars paid to prime contractor by City to date: \$211,235.61
Dollars paid to MBE by prime contractor to date: \$9,488 for 4.5% MBE.
Dollars paid to WBEs by prime contractor to date: \$58,548.36 for 28% WBE.

According to the prime contractor, the majority of Taliaferro & Browne’s work on the project is still pending. The prime contractor indicated that they do plan on meeting the goals of 13% MBE and 13% WBE.
