Brief Title

Vacation of a portion of right-of-way in District KCIA generally located north of W. 3rd Street in between Wyandotte Street to the west and Delaware Street to the east, to allow for relocation of the dumpster of the adjacent property which is now along Delaware to the vacated alley since the 2nd Street improvements have been completed.

Details

Location:
Generally located south of 2nd Street in between Wyandotte Street to the west and Delaware Street to the east.

Reason for Legislation:
To allow for relocation of the dumpster of the adjacent property which is now along Delaware to the vacated alley since the 2nd Street improvements have been completed.

CITY PLAN COMMISSION
The City Plan Commission heard this case on April 20, 2021. The Commission recommended approval of the vacation with two conditions.

BRIEF PROJECT DESCRIPTION
The area to be vacated is a small triangular piece of right-of-way located south of W. 2nd Street. The subject site does not currently serve any useful purpose. The Second + Delaware Apartments to the north were recently approved by Ordinance 200613 and one of the conditions of that plat (CLD-FnPlat-2020-00001) was for the developer to dedicate right-of-way to connect 2nd Street in this area and to vacate this portion of right-of-way. In addition, this area to be vacated will not serve any useful purpose in the near future. The adjacent property owner to the east intends to acquire this piece in order to relocate their trash enclosure.

The City Plan Commission recommended approval of this vacation, subject to four conditions.

RECOMMENDATION:
The City Plan Commission recommended approval of Case No. CD-ROW-2020-00022 with the following conditions:

1. That a utility easement is retained and protects all AT&T facilities. Any relocation of AT&T facilities shall be done at the applicant's expense.
2. That all streetlight facilities are retained and are not affected.
