Authorizing an Amendment No. 7 between the City of Kansas City, Missouri, Aviation Department and Executive Beechcraft, Inc. at the Charles B. Wheeler Downtown Airport.

Pete Fullerton and Mike Waller, Aviation, presented. This ordinance authorizes an amendment number 7 that edits and updates the Fixed Base Operator Agreement with Executive Beechcraft at The Charles B. Wheeler Downtown Airport. The amendment adds a section to the operator agreement to change the leasehold of Executive Beechcraft by taking out 561 square feet due to a public improvement, new fence line. This change results in a loss of \$140 per year.

The Lease Amendment with Executive Beechcraft, Inc. deletes and adds a new section 1.1, deletes and adds a new Part III, Supplemental Terms and Conditions to All Airport Agreements, and adds a new section 1.1.E from the Fixed Base Operations and Lease Agreement. Authorizing a \$9,293,000.00 Construction Contract with Garney Companies, Inc., for the Birmingham Pump Station Screen Replacement; authorizing a maximum expenditure of \$10,222,300.00; and authorizing a \$603,143.68 Design Professional Services Amendment No. 1 to Contract No. 1588, for the Birmingham Pump Station Screen Replacement project with Lion CSG, LLC, for a total contract amount of \$931,766.68; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.
