Details

Reason for Contract
Authorizing a \$2,625,836.50 contract with Superior Bowen Company, LLC. for the Runway 9-27 Pavement Repairs at KCI Airport; authorizing a maximum expenditure of \$3,151,003.80.

Discussion Project Justification The Pavement Condition Index (PCI) from our Pavement Management System indicates that the runway needs to be repaired. In order to remain eligible for future grants, the FAA requires maintenance and repairs to the pavement.
Project Description This project will involve a 2-1 1/2" hot mix asphalt (HMA) mill/overlay of the existing runway pavement outside of the keel section (inner 75' width) of Runway 9-27 at the Kansas City International Airport (MCI). Additional repairs will include full depth crack repair for approximately 2,000 linear feet based on an inspection of surface pavement.
Solicitation This Project was advertised in accordance with the City's requirements.
