Liquor Board to hold a hearing on May 28

The City of Kansas City, Missouri, Liquor Control Board of Review will conduct a hearing on Thursday, May 28, at 9:00 a.m. The meeting will be held at Regulated Industries Division in the conference room which is located at 635 Woodland Avenue Suite 2101 Kansas City, MO 64106.

This hearing, which involves "Cheema's Mini-Mart" which is located at 319 E 63rd Street, is regarding Cheema's Mini-Mart appealing the disapproval of the application for a Full Retail Sales and Sunday by the Package License based on density, location, and opposition from eligible voters was detriment.

Pursuant to §610.021 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, there may be a closed session to discuss legal matters, litigation or privileged communications with attorneys, pursuant to subsection (1).

The Liquor Control Board of Review consists of eight taxpaying residents of the city who are appointed by the mayor. Six of the members are designated as regular members and two of the members are designated as alternate members. The Liquor Control Board of Review conducts hearings whenever the manager, an applicant or an eligible consenter makes a request for a hearing based on the denial, approval or revocation of a liquor license by the manager.
