Whereas: This Student Senate is the Legislative Body of the

UMKC Student Government Association authorized to

deliberate, vote upon, and approve legislative acts; and

Whereas: The Student Senate represents 17,000+ students who

call the Kansas City community home at the University of

Missouri-Kansas City; and

Whereas: Troost Avenue runs through the University of Missouri-

Kansas City's Hospital Hill and Volker campus and

encompasses many communities along the way; and

Whereas: Troost Avenue honors Dr. Benoist Troost, the first

resident physician of the City of Kansas City who owned

and tortured slaves here in Kansas City; and

Whereas: The City of Kansas City and community members are

organizing to rename the street to no longer honor a slave

owner with the name, "Truth Avenue;" and

Wheras: In the words of Martin Luther King Jr, the man honored

with the new street name in place of Volker, "Those who do

nothing while witnessing injustice and wrongdoing do worse than those who commit acts of injustice." and;

Whereas: The Student Senate cannot stay silent while work is

being done to correct an injustice;

Therefore: Be it proclaimed by the UMKC Student Senate

assembled that the senate condemn the honoring of Dr.

Benoist Troost with Troost Avenue and support the efforts

to rename said street, "Truth Avenue."

Furthermore: May this proclamation represent the voice of

17,000+ UMKC students and Kansas Citians united in this

effort to correct this wrong, with a right.
