Reason for Legislation

To accept a contract from the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for HIV Medical Case Management for the period of 4/1/2012 to 3/31/13. The amount of the contract is \$710,000.00

Discussion

The purpose of this contract is to ensure that all residents living with HIV/AIDS within the 11 county Kansas City Transitional Grant Area (Cass, Clay, Clinton, Jackson, Johnson, Lafayette, Leavenworth, Miami, Platte, Ray, Wyandotte) receive medical case management services according to the policies, procedures, and standards of practice outlined and published by the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services.

The HIV Services program provided HIV/AIDS medical case management services for 2,264 unduplicated clients during the period from March 2011 to November 2011. These services are provided by approximately 40 medical case managers from seven different agencies (**Good Samaritan Project**, Guadalupe Center, **Kansas City Free Health Clinic**, **Kansas City Missouri Health Department**, **Truman Medical Center**, and the University of Kansas Hospital). The comprehensive system of care is monitored for the quality, programatic and fiscal integrity by the Kansas City Missouri Health Department, HIV Services Program.

Services under this Ryan White Part B contract will be provided by Good Samaritan Project, Truman Medical Center, Kansas City Health Department and KC Free Health Clinic.

Yes. These services are provided to mothers and children living with HIV/AIDS. During the most recent program year, 21% of the case management clients served were women, youth, infants, and/or children.

How will this contribute to a sustainable Kansas City?

Quality health care directly impacts the economic vitality, social equity and environmental quality of a community. promoting and protecting citizens of Kansas city is the goal for all public health programs. Individuals living with HIV/AIDS are required to enroll in Medical Case Management to access Ryan White medical services such as primary care, medications, oral health, mental health, substance abuse treatment services and insurance premium assistance. Funding for Medical Case Management ensures that residents living with HIV/AIDS within the Kansas City TGA receive appropriate health care services and treatment of their disease through federal, state and local funding resources.
