Amending Chapter 2, Code of Ordinances, by repealing Section 2-970.31, entitled "Establishment; membership; appointment of members," and replacing it with a new section of like number and title for the purpose of allowing high school freshmen and sophomores to serve on the Kansas City Youth Commission.

Discussion (including relationship to other Council actions)

Ordinance No. 140086 created the Kansas City Youth Commission, which serves as an advisory body to the Mayor, City Council and City Manager on matters and City programs affecting the youth in the City and making the City a better place for all in which to live.

This ordinance amendments changes the allowed grade levels for those participating from just juniors and seniors to all high school grade levels.
