1. Back to Business Fund Program Update

The Back to Business Fund Program Update highlighted the program's success in supporting local businesses, distributing funds to businesses across key industries. The update emphasized the program's role in job retention, economic recovery, and support for minority-and woman-owned businesses. Key metrics included the total funds disbursed, the number of businesses assisted, and the status of available funds. Success stories showcased the tangible impact on local businesses, while process improvements, such as streamlined applications and expanded outreach, aimed to increase accessibility. Looking ahead, the program plans to continue supporting underserved communities, with future updates on fund availability and deadlines for new applicants.

2. Staff from the Finance Department will present results of the independent audit the Annual Comprehensive Financial Report, along with the accompanying OMB Uniform Guidance Report, and the Popular Annual Financial Report, for the fiscal year ending April 30, 2024.

~Tammy Queen, Director of Finance, presented the Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR) for the fiscal year ending April 30, 2024, along with the OMB Uniform Guidance Report and the Popular Annual Financial Report (PAFR). The presentation highlighted the City's financial health, revenue, and expenditure trends, and affirmed a clean audit opinion from independent auditors, indicating accuracy and compliance with accounting standards. Key points included strong compliance with federal grant usage and funding guidelines, increased transparency through the PAFR for public engagement, and a focus on maintaining fiscal responsibility. The session concluded with a Q&A, emphasizing the City's commitment to financial accountability and continuous improvement.
