Brief Title:

Amending Chapter 2 Code of Ordinance, Section 2-2024, Conflict of interest annual report, and enacting in lieu thereof a new section of like number and subject matter.

Details

Reason for Legislation: The City of Kansas City is required to biennially adopt its policy for disclosing potential conflicts of interest pursuant to 105.485.4 RSMo. The City must adopt, by ordinance or resolution, its policy for disclosing potential conflicts of interest for 2015 at an open meeting by September 15, 2015.

There are a few changes to the ordinance.

- 1. Remove MAST Board
- 2. Replaced Convention Visitors Association with **VisitKC**
- 3. Replaced Port Authority with **PortKC**

Discussion (including relationship to other Council actions)

Section 105.485.4 RSMo allows the City to adopt its own policy for reporting potential conflicts of interest.

Under the City's policy, elected officials and certain staff members are required to file the long form of the Missouri Ethics Commission's Personal Financial Disclosure Statement with the City Clerk and the Missouri Ethics Commission. Members of certain boards and commissions are required to file a conflict of interest disclosure report on the form provided by the City Clerk. The form is provided by the Clerk's Office by February 1st of each year.

The City is required to adopt its policy biennially. The City must adopt its policy by September 15, 2015, and provide a certified copy to the Missouri Ethics Commission ten days after adoption.
