### **Executive Summary**

Appropriating \$150,000 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the General Fund (1000) to fund a wage disparity study and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

#### **Discussion**

The City has previously conducted a wage disparity study and has remained committed to ensuring mitigation of wage disparity. The FY 2025-2026 Budget included appropriations for a compensation study. The Human Resources Department require additional appropriations for the vendor to complete the additional scope of the wage disparity study.
