Purpose of HIV Prevention Grant:

To reduce new HIV infections through High Impact HIV Prevention Interventions. This grant supports the development and implementation of programs tailored to ending the HIV epidemic through HIV Prevention Activities .

Key Prevention Activities :

- Outreach Events (Community Engagement)
- HIV/ STI Testing
- Social Marketing/Social Media
- Condom Distribution
- Sexual Health Education
- PrEP Navigation
- Testing in Non-clinical settings
- Taking Care of Me” – a program supporting individuals living with HIV by addressing stigma and medication adherence



HIV Prevention Reach

In Calendar Year 2024, KCHD Prevention and Subrecipient Agencies:

- Tested 1,877 people for HIV across 648 testing events
- Distributed over 200,000 condoms
- Led 312 community outreach activities
- Reached 17,611 individuals to promote HIV testing, education on prevention methods, and safe sex strategies—
providing resources aimed at normalizing sexual health across the community
