RESOLUTION NO. 260138

Declaring Black History Month in Kansas City and authorizing the City Manager to fly the Pan-African Flag.

That the Mayor and Council hereby declare Black History Month to be observed from February 1 to March 1 and authorize the City Manager to fly the Pan-African Flag at City Hall.
