Reason

To allow the City to pay for and maintain enhancements on the Grand Blvd Bridge over I-670

Details

Reason for Legislation

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into a Municipal Agreement with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission related to the replacement of the Grand Boulevard Bridge over I-670; appropriating \$1,200,000.00 from the unappropriated Capital Improvements Fund balance; authorizing the Director of Public Works to expend \$1,200,000.00 for the project; designating requisitioning authority; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

Discussion (explain all financial aspects of the proposed legislation, including future implications, any direct/indirect costs, specific account numbers, ordinance references, and budget page numbers.)

On May 6, 2016 MoDOT closed the Grand Boulevard bridge over I-670 due to a structural failure. They are now completing an emergency bridge replacement design and plan to have the replacement bridge open in December, 2016. As part of this replacement the City desires to include enhanced bridge and roadway features beyond what MoDOT requires. These enhancements will include 12' wide sidewalks, widened ADA curb ramps, pedestrian signal push buttons and bike lanes. KCMO has been working in partnership with MoDOT for the City to provide funding for the construction of these enhancements.

Once the MoDOT bridge construction project is complete the City will install enhanced fencing and lighting on the bridge through a separate contract to complete the enhancements.

The purpose of this agreement is for the City to provide funding to MoDOT for the portion of these enhancements constructed through their bridge contract. The amount is not expected to exceed \$1,200,000.00. Upon completion of the project, the City will maintain the enhancements.
