 Authorizing Amendment No. 2 to a design professional services agreement with McClure Engineering Company, for \$188,955.00 in the 23rd Street Improvements project, for a total contract amount of \$522,848.00.

Discussion
 This ordinance authorizes Amendment No. 2 to a design professional services agreement with McClure Engineering Company for the 23rd Street Improvements project.

Project Description
 The amendment will provide funding for redesign of the roadway and water line design.

Contract Summary
 Amendment 1 - Extended the limits of the project to incorporate the entire section of 23rd Street from Benton Avenue (Chestnut Avenue) up to the interchange with Interstate 70
 Amendment 2 - Updates plans to reflect the change in roadway design to incorporate shared-use paths on both sides of the streets for the majority of the corridor. Additional design work for relocation of existing water mains in conjunction with the roadway.
