Executive Summary

Authorizing the Director of the Aviation Department to enter into a \$6,474,198.45 construction contract with Ideker, Inc. for the TWY J Rehab & K Reconstruction project at the Kansas City International Airport (MCI).

Discussion

THE DBE CREO CUP WAS APPROVED FOR 24.50% DBE, PARTICIPATION.

The intent of this project is to reconstruct the section of Taxiway K with Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) and Mill and Overlay with asphalt a section of Taxiway J at the Kansas City International Airport (MCI). The rehabilitation of Taxiway J will include milling the existing concrete and overlaying it with asphalt pavement. The rehabilitation will also include the mill and overlay of the asphalt pavement shoulders. The section of Taxiway J that will be rehabilitated is between the North end of Taxiway J and the Taxiway J-K intersection. The scope on Taxiway K will include reconstruction of the Taxiway with concrete. The section of Taxiway K that will be reconstructed is between Taxiway F and the west end of Taxiway K.
