Executive Summary

Authorizing the City Manager to execute an Access and Use Agreement with the Port Authority of Kansas City for the construction and maintenance of a trail extension along the Missouri River

Discussion

Over the past 25 years, the City has constructed a network of trails along the Missouri River commonly known as the Riverfront Heritage Trail, part of which connects the Town of Kansas Bridge to the Berkley Riverfront Heritage Park. An opportunity exists to extend the trail west from the Town of Kansas to Liberty Street. The City currently owns unimproved real property adjacent to the Missouri River commonly known as 52 Delaware Street and 10 Broadway Boulevard, which could be utilized to extend the Riverfront Heritage Trail from the Town of Kansas Bridge to Liberty Street. The Port Authority of Kansas City is willing to design, construct, operate, and maintain the trail extension at no cost to City. The Access and Use Agreement authorized under this ordinance would grant rights to the Port Authority to execute this proposal.
