#### **Executive Summary**

Authorizing a \$1,650,000.00 construction contract with Leath & Sons, Inc., for the Water Department Emergency Transmission Main Repair contract; and authorizing four successive one-year renewal options for a maximum expenditure of \$8,250,000.00 with further City Council approval.

#### **Discussion**

#### **Project Justification**

KC Water is undertaking this project to make scheduled and emergency repairs to the transmission water mains throughout the City's water distribution system.

#### **Project Description**

The scope of work to be provided under this contract will include scheduled and emergency transmission water main repairs to the City's water distribution system.

Unit prices for the work to be completed under this contract were set based on the bids received. Therefore, KC Water proposes a not to exceed \$1,650,000.00 contract to complete restoration work orders.

This ordinance also authorizes the Director of Water Services to execute four successive one-year renewal options for this contract with additional City Council approval.

This contract is based on unit prices with a maximum expenditure of \$1,650,000.00 for a term of one year with four potential successive one-year renewals at \$1,650,000.00 per year at the City's option (for a total of \$8,250,000.00 over five years).

The term of this contract is 365 calendar days.

#### **MBE/WBE Goals**

CREO KC established goals of 11% MBE and 11% WBE for this construction project on February 14, 2024 as part of the CREO KC Annual Goal Program.

#### **Solicitation**

This project was advertised in accordance with the City's requirements. Public bids were opened on April 2, 2024 with 7 bidders responding.

#### **Awardee/Subcontracting Participation**

Leath & Sons, Inc. was selected for this project as the lowest, most responsive, and most responsible bidder with a bid amount of \$864,579.00, with subcontracting participation of 11% MBE and 11% WBE. The maximum obligation of the City for the work on this project will be \$1,650,000.00.

#### **Discussion**

#### **Project Justification**

The existing Water Treatment Plant located at 1 N.W. Briarcliff Road is over 100 years old and upkeep costs are increasing. The Water Services Department seeks to identify and conceptualize a new Water Treatment Plant in the general area of the East Bottoms. The new Water Treatment Plant would provide:

- Resilient Infrastructure for future generations of Kansas Citians.
- Increased reliability of Raw Water Sources.
- Reduced risk of water supply shutdowns due to point source operational risks (i.e. if there was only one Water Treatment Plant).
- Opportunity to utilize modern treatment technologies to optimize chemical usage.
- Opportunity to utilize emerging technologies to remove potential contaminants.
- Reduce current operation and maintenance (O&M) costs by maintaining existing systems in limited space, limited structures, and limited shutdown schedules.

#### **Project Description**

This project entails the development of a facility plan for a South Water Treatment Plant and water sourcing and conveyance to account for changing conditions in the service area and be able to address future regulatory requirements. The facility plan will include:



WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 221013 was approved on December 18, 2022, approving a \$9,107,589.00 construction contract under Contract No. 9735 with SHEDIGS IT, LLC, for the Water Main Replacement in the Area of Southwest Boulevard to Main Street, W. 43rd Street to Pershing Avenue project and authorizing a maximum expenditure of \$10,018,348.00; and

WHEREAS, the City executed a \$329,983.00 Change Order No. 1 on November 7, 2023, for additional water main repair/relocation/adjustment/restoration work and fire hydrant assembly and restoration in the project area and a 14 day time extension; and

WHEREAS, the City executed a \$564,030.05 Change Order No. 2 on March 18, 2024, for additional emergency construction work and fire hydrant installations in the project area and a 60 day time extension; and

WHEREAS, this proposed \$194,728.76 Change Order No. 3 is for restoration, addition of a 6-inch water service line, an emergency repair, and a credit for work not performed in the project area, with the contract total increasing to \$10,196,330.81; NOW, THEREFORE,

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:
