Executive Summary

Approving the recommendations of Arterial Street Impact Fee District G Committee; appropriating \$575,000.00 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Arterial Street Impact Fee Fund to Holmes Road – 137th Street to Blue Ridge Boulevard Project in the Arterial Street Impact Fee Fund; designating requisitioning authority and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

The Arterial Impact Fee District G Committee voted in favor to allocate \$575,000.00 toward the Holmes Road – 137th Street to Blue Ridge Boulevard Project. This project will enhance roadway infrastructure, addressing connectivity and mobility needs within the district.
