ORDINANCE NO. 250038

Accepting and approving a grant award in the amount of \$2,196,300.00 with the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development for Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA), authorizing the Chief Procurement Officer to execute contracts with SAVE, Inc, in the amount of \$1,411,672.00, and Vivent Health in the amount of \$538,996.00; authorizing the Chief Procurement Officer to extend the term of the contract or increase the total contract dollar amount upon need and appropriation without further Council approval; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That a grant award in the amount of \$2,196,300.00 between the City of Kansas City, Missouri, acting through its Director of Health, and the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD), whereby HUD will provide funding for Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) from May 1, 2024 through April 30, 2027, for an amount not to exceed \$2,196,300.00, is hereby accepted and approved. A copy of the agreement, in substantial form, is on file with the Director of Health.

Section 2. That the Director of Procurement is authorized to execute a contract with SAVE, Inc., for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,411,672.00, and with Vivent Health, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$538,996.00, for HOPWA transitional housing assistance for eligible residents in Kansas City, Missouri, to be paid from funds appropriated in Account No. 25-2740-505004-B-G50245426. A copy of the contracts, in substantial form, are on file with the Director of Health.

Section 3. That the Director is hereby authorized to extend the term of the SAVE, Inc., and Vivent Health contracts without further Council approval and that the Director is also hereby authorized to amend these contracts to increase or decrease the total contract dollar amount contingent upon the need and availability of appropriated funds.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is recognized as an ordinance with an accelerated effective date as provided by Section 503(a)(3)(C) of the City Charter in that it appropriates money and shall take effect in accordance with that section.

I hereby certify that there is a balance, otherwise unencumbered, to the credit of the appropriation to which the foregoing expenditure is to be charged, and a cash balance, otherwise unencumbered, in the treasury, to the credit of the fund from which payment is to be made, each sufficient to meet the obligation hereby incurred.
