

**TENANT REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT
AMENDMENT NO. EIGHT**

This amendment is between KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, a constitutionally chartered municipal corporation (City), and Trammell Crow Kansas City Development, Inc. (Lessee). The parties amend the Agreement entered into on March 28, 2007, as follows:

Sec. 1. Section Amended. The Agreement is amended as follows:

A. Part I, Sec. 1. Compensation. A. is hereby revised as follows:

Part I, Sect. 1. Compensation. A. The amount the City will pay Lessee under this Agreement will not exceed \$34,300,082.97.

5. A new amount of \$5,100,000 for additional construction services.

Sec. 2. Sections not Amended. All other sections of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

Sec. 3. Authorization. If the amount of the original Agreement plus the amount of any amendments to the original Agreement total over \$301,000.00, then this amendment requires City Council or Park Board authorization.

Sec. 4. Effectiveness; Date. This amendment will become effective when the City's Director of Finance has signed it. The date this amendment is signed by the City's Director of Finance will be deemed the date of this amendment.

Each party is signing this amendment on the date stated opposite that party's signature.
