Honoring Aubrey Anderson for completing the Clay County America 250 Citizen Challenge.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

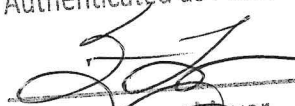
That the Mayor and Council hereby celebrate this achievement by Aubrey Anderson and thanks her for accepting the Citizen Challenge; and
