4. PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The project aims to replace outdated infrastructure, enhance pumping capacity, and ensure the long-term reliability and efficiency of the water supply system. Key elements include the construction of four new vertical collection wells to improve water capture, the removal of existing wells and vaults to make space for new infrastructure, and excavation for the installation of new well vaults. The project also involves the installation of new 36-inch diameter water supply

wells and high efficiency pumps to increase pumping capacity, along with the creation of new access platforms for safe maintenance and operation. Additionally, the project will upgrade the system’s instrumentation to improve monitoring and control, and it will include the installation of a new electrical duct bank to support the increased power requirements of the new infrastructure. This comprehensive upgrade will modernize the water supply system, improve operational efficiency, and ensure a reliable water source for the community

Cost Proposal submittals were retained by the Procurement Officer until the public bid opening held on February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at the KC Water Administration Building, located at 4800 E 63<sup>rd</sup> Street, Kansas City, MO 64130.




