WHEREAS, the resilience, skill, and unwavering service of these telecommunicators contribute significantly to the safety and well-being of the Kansas City community; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

That the Mayor and Council hereby recognize National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week and extend our deepest gratitude to the Kansas City Fire Department's Emergency Communications personnel and Jackson County's 911 Emergency Services for their outstanding service; and
