## ORDINANCE NO. 110100

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to execute a contract with Standard Parking to provide the management and operation of the Kansas City Power and Light Parking Garages; authorizing the Director to extend the contract for up to three (3) additional one year periods; authorizing the Director of Public Works to expend up to \$245,210.67 from previously appropriated funds.

WHEREAS, the City solicited proposals for the management and operation of the Kansas City Power and Light Parking Garages, containing approximately 2,899 parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, Standard Parking was determined to be the best proposer and has been selected to provide this service; and

WHEREAS, Standard Parking will provide full management and operation of the Kansas City Power and Light Parking Garages with passage of this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, funds have been appropriated for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2010; NOW, THEREFORE,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to execute, on behalf of City, a contract with Standard Parking beginning January 1, 2011 through April 30, 2011 for the management and operation of the Kansas City Power and Light Parking Garages (13<sup>th</sup> & Walnut/Block 110, H&R Block/Block 125, President Hotel/Block 124 and KC Live/Block 126).

Section 2. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to expend \$245,210.67 from funds previously appropriated to the following accounts:
