ORDINANCE NO. 140176

Accepting and approving a \$69,184.05 contract amendment with the University of Kansas Hospital Authority to provide Medical Case Management Services in the Kansas City area; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That a contract amendment between the City of Kansas City, Missouri, acting through its Director of Health, and the University of Kansas Hospital Authority, acting through its Executive Director, whereby the University of Kansas Hospital Authority will provide Medical Case Management Services for eligible residents in the Kansas City area for the contract period of March 1, 2013 through May 31, 2014, for a total amount not to exceed \$313,795.05, to be paid from funds previously appropriated in Account No. 14-2730-505003-B-G50244815, is hereby accepted and approved. A copy of the amendment, in substantial form, is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

Section 2. That the Director is hereby authorized to extend the term of this contract without further Council approval and that the Director is also hereby authorized to amend this contract to increase or decrease the total contract dollar amount contingent upon the need and availability of appropriated funds.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared an emergency measure within the provisions of Section 503(a)(2) of the City Charter in that it relates to the immediate preservation of the public health, and shall take effect in accordance with that section.
