RESOLUTION NO. 250633

Recognizing the UnidosUS 2025 Annual Conference: "Beacons of Change."

WHEREAS, the UnidosUS 2025 Annual Conference will be held from August 5–7, 2025, at the Kansas City Convention Center in Kansas City, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the UnidosUS Annual Conference serves as a powerful platform for sharing innovative strategies, informing policy, and strengthening partnerships that support Latino communities nationwide; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 conference presents an opportunity to celebrate Latino culture, leadership, and contributions to the social, economic, and civic life of our nation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

That the Mayor and Council hereby recognize and commend UnidosUS for hosting the 2025 Annual Conference in Kansas City, Missouri, and extend their warmest welcome to all participants who will gather to serve as "Beacons of Change" for Latino communities across the country; and
