### **Alcohol Beverage Advisory Group to meet **December 15****

The City of Kansas City, Missouri's Alcohol Beverage Advisory Group will conduct its next meeting on **Monday, December 15, 2025**, at **9:00 a.m.** The meeting will be held at Regulated Industries Division at Century Towers, 635 Woodland Avenue, in suite 2101.

At this meeting, the Alcohol Beverage Advisory Group will:

- Discuss an amendment proposal that would restrict the retail package sale of certain alcohol products by the package within defined geographic areas to promote public safety, public health, and neighborhood stability.

The Alcoholic Beverage Advisory Group consists of 12 members from the community and the manager of the Regulated Industries Division. The purpose of the group is to review recommended changes to Chapter 10 of the City Ordinance when they are made. Recommendations are made regarding public safety and take into consideration new standards and advances within the liquor industry as they may apply to the current liquor laws. The manager of Regulated Industries Division shares the Alcohol Beverage Advisory Group's recommendations with the City Council for further review and consideration.
