The overall Shoal Creek Parkway improvements include creating bicycle lanes, a natural median and new connections from existing neighborhoods to the City's road network. The improvements create a new green transportation network with the bicycle lanes, a natural median area for native habitat and will reduce vehicle trips. The proposed water transmission main, an important component of the parkway improvements, will provide for future water demand for adjacent northland communities. Water Services will be coordinating its waterline work with the Shoal Creek Parkway/North Oak Trafficway Transportation Development District and Public Works Department for efficiencies and to avoid costly rework.
