Executive Summary

Authorizing execution of a contract amendment with the Economic Development Corporation of Kansas City, Missouri in an amount not to exceed \$166,224.00 for the purpose of providing funds for the creation of a ProspectUs advisory group and the funding of a ProspectUS Plan Manager.

Discussion

This ordinance authorizes a the First Amendment to the FY2025-2026 contract with the Economic Development Corporation of Kansas City, Missouri to provide EDC funds to create a ProspectUs advisory group and fund a ProspectUS Plan Manager to support the implementation of the ProspectUs Equitable Transit Oriented Development Strategic Plan. This transfers funding established in the FY 2025-26 Budget for the creation of two Development Specialist positions within the City Planning and Development department, to the Economic Development Corporation. Through this amendment the EDC will provide director level support and services to coordinate implementation of this plan across a variety of stakeholders.
