Reason for Legislation

Estimating revenue in the amount of \$685,200.00 into the Capital Improvements Sales Tax Fund; appropriating that amount to the NW Prairie View Road Improvements Project; authorizing execution of an Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement with the City of Platte Woods for the design and construction this project; authorizing execution of a Transportation Alternatives Funds Program Agreement with the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission, Grant Number STP 3301(483) for the construction of the Project; directing the City Clerk to file certain documents with the appropriate offices; and designating requisitioning authority.

Discussion

This project is for the design and construction of sidewalks along NW Prairie View Road between NW 77th Terrace and Tower Drive and at the intersection of NW Prairie View Road and Route 9. These improvements impact the Platte Woods business areas and KCMO neighborhoods and businesses nearby. The project will also convert existing shoulders into bicycle lanes.

The project lies across the boundaries of both municipalities. The intergovernmental agreement provides that the City of Kansas City will undertake management of the design and construction of the project. Platte Woods is providing \$235,200.00 for this project to pay for their pro-rata share of all costs associated with the project. Both cities are committing themselves to work cooperatively in the execution of the project.

The \$450,000 funding through Transportation Alternative Funds was originally granted to the City of Platte Woods. Because the project will be managed by Kansas City, all parties agree that the administrative burden to the project would be reduced if the grant was awarded to and managed by Kansas City.

Kansas City's share of \$254,800 is being provided by Council District 2 PIAC funds. The total estimated project cost is \$940,000.
