

240513: HIV Prevention

- Previous award (\$176,423.33) accepted in October 2023 (230900).
 - Covered the period of January 1, 2024 through May 31, 2024.
- Current award (\$73,568) is a two-month extension from CDC/MDHSS to cover services June 1, 2024 until July 31, 2024. Total award covering seven months of programming = \$249,991.33
- Replacement grant (PS24-0047) has been identified and is expected to start August 1, 2024

240513: HIV Prevention

- Through this two-month extension KCHD and two subrecipient agencies will:
 - Provide outreach and education to the community on HIV prevention, Safe Sex, STIs, PrEP, and risk reduction
 - Conduct outreach testing
 - Provide clinical counseling testing and referral services
 - And engage in social marketing efforts
- Grant activities focus on populations disproportionately impacted by HIV: African American Women, African American Men, White MSM, Hispanic individuals.
