The ending General Fund balance for FY 2023-24 is estimated to be \$209.5 million and the fund balance target of two months of operating expenditures pursuant to Section 2-1954 of the Code of Ordinances is estimated at \$103.2 million. This ordinance estimates additional revenue of \$6,600 for the remainder FY 2023-24 and \$7,200 annually through FY 2025-26.
