

RESOLUTION NO. 180829

Honoring Gene Daugherty on the occasion of his retirement after 12½ years of dedicated service to the City of Kansas City, Missouri.

WHEREAS, Gene Daugherty has been employed by the City of Kansas City, Missouri for twelve and a half years; and

WHEREAS, Gene began his IT career working for the Wyandotte County Court System then moved on to become a Computer Network Administrator with the Unified Government of Wyandotte County before joining the City; and

WHEREAS, Gene Daugherty became a City employee on March 27, 2006, when he joined the IT Department as a Software Analyst and continued to work for the IT Department through its transition to a Division of General Services; and

WHEREAS, in 2008, Gene was promoted to IT Senior Analyst, the position he retires from today with his skills, knowledge, and dedication having served the City well, and having made him a respected and trusted colleague and friend; and

WHEREAS, Gene Daugherty has, during his tenure, been responsible for laying the foundation of embracing new, more efficient technologies to improve City services. This includes implementing a virtual server environment that initially allowed the conversion of 146 physical servers down to seven physical hosts, which now house over 250 virtual servers. With his virtual server experience Gene was personally instrumental in the consolidation of the OneIT Data Centers; NOW, THEREFORE,

That the Mayor and Council hereby salute Gene Daugherty on the occasion of his retirement, and thank him for his dedicated service to the City; and
