# **Executive Summary**

Authorizing the Director of the Aviation Department to enter into a \$9,812,409.76 construction contract with Brown & Root Industrial Service, LLC for the AOA Fence Replacement Phase 1 at the Kansas City International Airport (MCI); and appropriating \$10,793,650.74 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Aviation Fund.

### Discussion

THE MWDBE CREO CUP WAS APPROVED FOR 10.7% DBE PARTICIPATION.

The primary purpose of this project is to replace the existing Air Operations Area (AOA) fence and gates at Kansas City International Airport (MCI). The design will include both 8-foot and 10-foot chain-link fence with 1-foot barbed wire and a 4-foot wildlife deterrent skirt. The 10-foot sections have been limited to areas of greatest wildlife crossing concerns. The scope of this project includes the replacement of the existing AOA fence and gates from the north side of Post 2, along Cargo Row, around the west side of the airfield, ending just past Post 18. The project will also include the installation and removal of temporary AOA fence, adjustments of the AOA perimeter roadway, storm drainage, grading, and culvert improvements along the perimeter fence.
