2020B (assuming a 4.7% true interest rate):

Average Annual Debt Service: 506,486.00
Total Debt Service 10,100,182.00

2020C (assuming a 2 % true interest rate):

Average Annual Debt Service: 4,009,103.00
Total Debt Service 9,532,756.00
