



Environmental Health Services Non-Mobile Food Vendor Permit

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<u>Purpose</u>

- To create a new non-mobile food vendor permit that will accommodate "pop-up" style restaurants, while maintaining the integrity of food safety practices and regulations of the KCMO Food Code.
- The Non-Mobile Food Vendor Permit is a way to generate opportunities to these small businesses as a way for them to expand their current businesses and thrive in Kansas City.

Non-Mobile Food Vendor PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

- Vendor operates 3 predetermined locations
- Maintain a food commissary permitted through a regulatory authority
- Permit Fee = \$230.00 annually

- Limited to service of only:
 - Non-time/temperature control for safety foods;
 - Pre-prepared time/temperature control for safety foods maintained at proper temperatures; or
 - Preparation of pre-cooked foods offered for retail sale.



Non-Mobile Food Vendor PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

- Handwashing sink easily accessible with pressurized hot and cold water at serving location with proper overhead protection
- All food shall be obtained from sources that comply with all laws related to food and food labeling.

- During food service operation, permit must be displayed in an area that is conspicuous to the consumer.
- Annual Permit (January December)



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
