



Environmental Health Services **Non-Mobile Food Vendor Permit**

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Purpose

- **To create a new non-mobile food vendor permit that will accommodate “pop-up” style restaurants, while maintaining the integrity of food safety practices and regulations of the KCMO Food Code.**
- **The Non-Mobile Food Vendor Permit is a way to generate opportunities to these small businesses as a way for them to expand their current businesses and thrive in Kansas City.**

Non-Mobile Food Vendor **PERMIT REQUIREMENTS**

- **Vendor operates 3 predetermined locations**
- **Maintain a food commissary permitted through a regulatory authority**
- **Permit Fee = \$230.00 annually**
- **Limited to service of only:**
 - **Non-time/temperature control for safety foods;**
 - **Pre-prepared time/temperature control for safety foods maintained at proper temperatures; or**
 - **Preparation of pre-cooked foods offered for retail sale.**

Non-Mobile Food Vendor **PERMIT REQUIREMENTS**

- **Handwashing sink easily accessible with pressurized hot and cold water at serving location with proper overhead protection**
- **All food shall be obtained from sources that comply with all laws related to food and food labeling.**
- **During food service operation, permit must be displayed in an area that is conspicuous to the consumer.**
- **Annual Permit (January – December)**



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
