The US 169 Buck O'Neil Bridge Project impacts multiple City streets such as 4th Street, Woodswether, Broadway 5th Street, 3rd Street, and Richards Road. The agreement stipulates that MoDOT will utilize the City's right of way to reconstruct portions of these streets required for the construction of the new US 169 Buck O'Neil Bridge and interchanges at I-70 and the Charles B. Wheeler Downtown Airport. The City would be responsible for the sidewalk and trail connections to and from the new Bridge. The estimated maintenance costs are assumed to be for removal of vegetation encroachment on the pedestrian facilities. The reconstructed streets will not need to be included in the street resurfacing program for this project.
